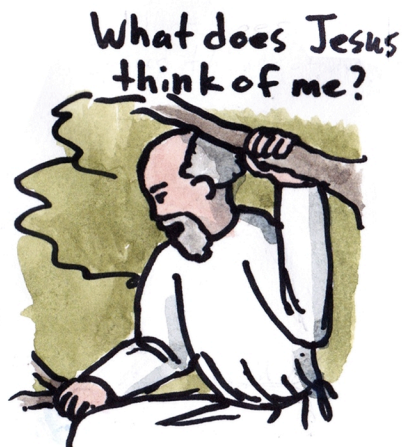


Does Jesus Want To Forgive Your Sins?

I must stay at your house today.

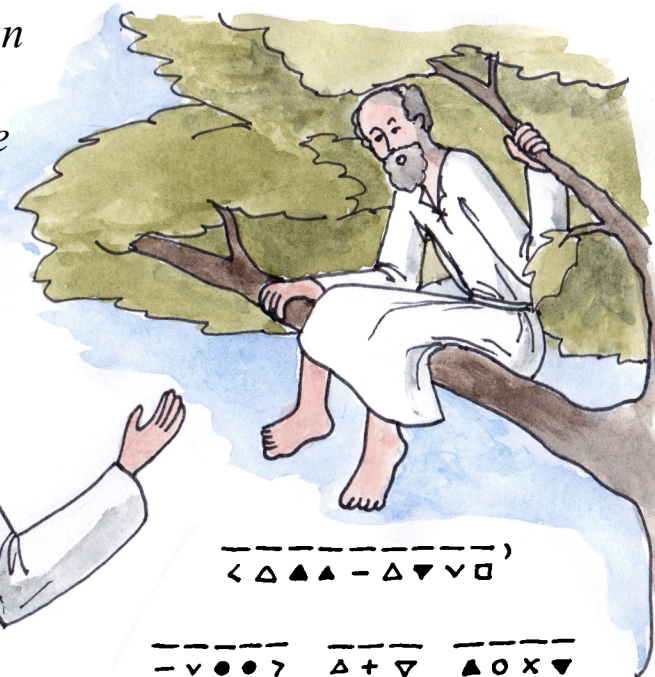
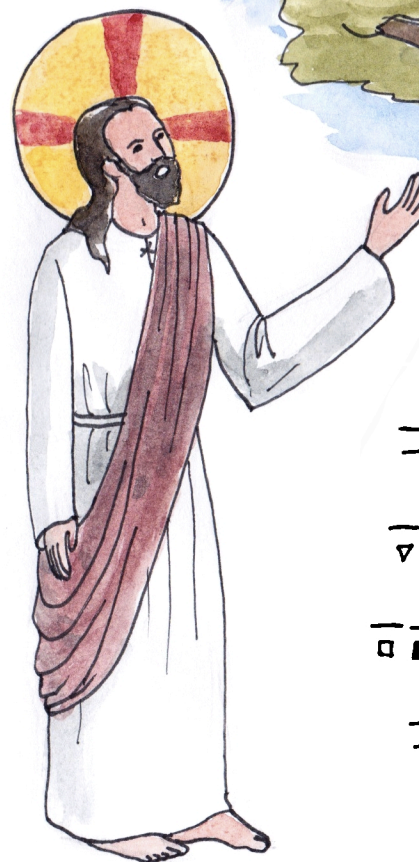
Answer to front: Zacchaeus, hurry and come down.
